JOINT EXTREME DESTITUTION AND EMPLOYMENT NETWORK MEETING

We are delighted to invite you to this year's Joint Extreme Destitution and Employment Network Meeting, taking place in Santander, Spain on the 24th and 25th of September 2024. This year, we will focus on the topic of Employment C Poverty: Promoting opportunities for vulnerable groups. The linkage between poverty and employment will be discussed from two different perspectives: We will firstly focus on access to employment for people in vulnerable situations. Many different groups face a broad range of difficulties and barriers in accessing the labor market. Nueva Vida will give us insights into their approach on how to integrate people from disadvantaged backgrounds, such as women in prostitution contexts or women trafficked for sexual exploitation, refugees, people experiencing homelessness, or former prisoners, and what role not-for-profit organizations can play.

Secondly, we will shed light on in-work poverty. In the context of the cost-of-living crisis, disposable income is shrinking for many people, making it harder for families and people at risk of poverty and social exclusion to cover their costs. Consequently, despite having a job, their income might not be enough to make ends meet and break the cycle of poverty. We will discuss the current situation in Europe, specific challenges faced by people in vulnerable situations, and possible policy approaches on how to support those in need.

Both perspectives will be linked through the sharing of best practices, discussing our members' challenges, and developing policy recommendations.

Participants

The meeting is open to anyone working in Diaconia who is part of a network or organization that is a member of Eurodiaconia. Those who are likely to find it most interesting are staff members working on supporting people affected by in-work poverty and providing access to employment for vulnerable people and people at risk of poverty and exclusion, as well as organizations interested in developing their work on those topics.

Directions from airport

To travel from Santander Airport to Hotel Faranda Express Alisas Santander by public transport, you can take the Alsa bus service from the airport to the city center. The bus stop is located just outside the airport terminal, and the journey to Santander city center takes approximately 15 minutes. Once you arrive at the city center, you can either walk or take a short taxi ride to the hotel, which is located at Nicolás Salmerón Street, 3. Walking from the bus station to the hotel takes about 10 minutes, making it a convenient and straightforward route.






<u>From Hotel Faranda Express Alisas Santander to the Centro Cívico Juan Carlos</u> Calderón

To walk from Hotel Faranda Express Alisas Santander to the Centro Cívico Juan Carlos Calderón in Santander, start by heading east on Nicolás Salmerón Street. Continue straight until you reach the intersection with Calle Castilla, then turn left onto Calle Castilla. Walk along Calle Castilla for about 500 meters until you reach the intersection with Calle Alta. Turn right onto Calle Alta and continue walking for approximately 200 meters. The Centro Cívico Juan Carlos Calderón will be on your right-hand side. The entire walk takes around 15-20 minutes, depending on your pace.
