Apostoli is a non-profit organization supporting refugees and migrants in Greece through accommodation, integration, and non-formal education. It runs creative activity centers and vocational training programs, and partners internationally to deliver emergency aid in the Greek islands. Driven by Christian principles, Apostoli provides comprehensive support to vulnerable groups to enhance their living conditions and integration.

Migration and asylum remain as one of the main concerns for Europeans. During the last 4 years, the migration debate has been ruled by opposing perspectives on the recently adopted New Pact on Migration and Asylum. This pact contains the revised policies and regulations governing migration, asylum, integration and border management.

Public dialogue has been shaped by a crisis narrative surrounding migration, which has exacerbated negative stereotypes and biases, leading to the polarisation of our societies and creating tensions between hosting communities and newcomers. The former poses a significant obstacle for the sustainable integration and inclusion of migrants and refugees.
